

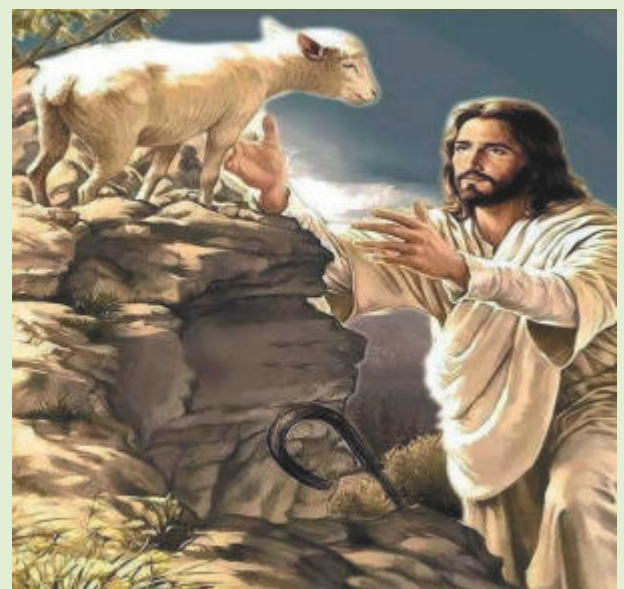

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER JONAS

Today is Good Shepherd Sunday. In today's Gospel Jesus describes himself as a good shepherd. Jesus says, "The sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out." The sheep know his voice. We are his sheep. We know his voice. We know if something we hear is coming from him or from another source.

We know his voice in many ways. First, we can tell if he is calling us to do something or not to do something through our conscience. We know right from wrong. We do not have to be moral theologians to know that people who post harmful things about others or the internet are doing something very wrong. We do not get our morality from civil law. We don't judge the merits of something according to whether or not there is a law about it; the voice of the Lord determines it. We know also know that whether we are caught or not has nothing to do with whether something is right or wrong.

Our conscience also speak to us by continually asking us, "How well am I living my Christianity"? The Christian lives his or her Christianity throughout our daily life, in the home, at the workplace, in the world. Many of the young and not so young, make time to volunteer in our parish for the poor, for the children or for the elderly people or in the hospice or hospital. You are acting on the voice you hear within you saying, "I have to do something to help out." I am only doing what a Christian must do to be a Christian."

Sometimes, we need to listen carefully the voice of the Lord. There are so many distractions in life, that we have to listen closely to hear his voice. That is why we need to make time in our lives for daily prayer. Those prayers we say at night or in the morning every day. This is what we do to hear his voice and to follow our shepherd.

When we should stay at home due to Covid-19, it is a good time to pray to enjoy God's presence and listen to his voice.
